While this title is a catchy alliteration, the word "matters" in the title was actually chosen because of its two meanings. First, it can mean "things". This article is about things related to money. Second, it can mean having importance or significance. This article also highlights how your financial contributions to the Operating Fund are important and vital at this time.

STEWARDSHIP UPDATE

Thank you for faithfully participating in the ministries of Utica UMC by sharing your prayers, your presence, your gifts, and your service. Our stewardship program this year focused on Fulfilling God's Purpose including living as servants and giving generously. If you haven't already returned your financial commitment or service commitment, please return them to the office as soon as possible. Extra copies are available in the Narthex, Fellowship Hall, or office.

As of this week, we have received 58 financial commitment cards, pledging \$258,000 for our Operating Fund. We have also received 51 service commitments. Your financial gifts and service are deeply appreciated.

NOVEMBER / DECEMBER \$\$ NEEDS AND OPPORTUNITIES

In November and December your <u>contributions</u> to the <u>Operating Fund are essential</u> to enable us to meet our remaining expenses for 2025. These include: Compensation (\$37,500); Utilities (\$8,100); Church Insurance (\$8,000); Ministry Shares (\$15,000); Property Upkeep (\$17,000); and Ministries/Administration (\$12,000). Operating Fund gifts totaling \$45,000 - \$50,000 <u>each month</u> are needed to meet these expenses. We are grateful for those who have made extra contributions since our appeal in September. Every contribution, no matter the size, makes a difference. The Operating Fund provides the foundation for everything we do.

YEAR-END CONTRIBUTIONS

Your contributions for 2025 must be received in the office by the end of the day Tuesday, December 30 or be posted in eGiving by December 31 to be counted towards 2025. Gifts of stocks, mutual funds, or other assets need to be transferred into our brokerage account before December 31. Tax laws are changing for 2026. Look into what's changing. It may influence your giving decisions for 2025. Consider using IRA qualified distributions if you are over 70 1/2, donor advised funds, or gifts of appreciated assets as options to have a positive tax benefit for yourself and support Utica UMC.

In 2 Corinthians 9:7–8 it says, "You must each decide in your heart how much to give. And don't give reluctantly or in response to pressure. "For God loves a person who gives cheerfully." And, God will generously provide all you need."


